

Camp Rose 2020 COVID-19 Health & Well-being Procedures

This page is intended to provide parents and campers with an overview of changes in policies and procedures for this year's camp experience and is subject to change as more information becomes available.

Health Screening

All children are required to complete a daily health check at the camp drop off location point. This will include a temperature check and brief wellness survey.

If a child has a temperature that exceeds 100.4, they will be asked to leave for the day. Children not admitted to camp due to illness are documented. Children must remain fever free for 24 hours without any fever reducing medication before being readmitted to care.

If a camper develops symptoms after admittance to camp, they will be separated from the group until pickup by parent/guardian.

The Rose E. Schneider Family YMCA reserves the right to decline entry for any child who looks and/or sounds unwell).

Masks

Children will be asked to wear masks only when social distancing is not possible. Parents are asked to wear a mask when engaging with our staff and other participants/members when physical distancing is not possible. Staff will be required to wear masks indoors at all time aside from when engaging in physical activity or are able to social distance themselves.

General

Alcohol based hand sanitizer will be applied throughout the day and regular handwashing will be occur as well.

The Y has implemented routine cleaning procedures throughout the day, disinfecting high volume surfaces such as doorknobs, tables, and bathrooms.

All personal items should be taken home daily. Campers should leave all non-essential items at home.

Campers will be in smaller groups of 10 to minimize intermixing of children and staff.

Campers will engage in activities that promote social distancing and we will do so to the best of our ability.

All field trips have been cancelled for the 2020 camp season.

Swimming will be limited to 2-3 times per week.

Campers will provide their own breakfast, lunch and snack.

YMCA Members

During the camp day, your child will come in limited contact with members of our facility. For your reference, our member protocol is as follows.

Members will wear a mask into the building and have a temperature check at the Membership Service Desk. With a temperature below 100.4, and without any COVID-19 related symptoms, members will be permitted to scan their membership card and enter the physical side of the building. Members will not need to wear a mask while in the physical part of the building (locker rooms, Gymnasium, swimming pools, wellness center). Members will need to wear their mask when exiting the physical part of the building and while in the lobby area.
